- Teacher recommendation(s) based on student work that reflects academic issues and/or effort; or,
- Parent/guardian recommendation(s) based on academic need.

In an effort to ensure that your child is able to benefit for increased opportunities to be better able to learn the academic skills and concepts necessary for academic success, s/he will participate in basic skills instruction in English language arts and mathematics during the school day, after school, and/or during a summer school program. For each of these academic programs, will receive letters requesting permission for your child to participate in the supplemental academic services offered.

Your child may exit or no longer receive Title I services if:

- Demonstrated performance on standardized assessments is "proficient" or better; and
- Diagnostic and/or benchmark assessments results show on or above grade level performance; or,
- Grades in English language arts and/or mathematics are at least "85" or better.
