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## East Newark Public School POLICY

### Multiple Measures Used to Determine Student Eligibility to Receive Title I Services

The administration of East Newark School will consider four factors when determining the eligibility of a student to receive services supported by federal government Title I funds. The four factors (equal weight) are:

- Scores (beginning in grade 3) on state standardized tests (did the student receive a score that is recognized by the N.J. State Department of Education as “satisfactory” or “passing”?)
- School made benchmark assessments (did the student receive a passing score?)
- Report card grades (did the student receive satisfactory grades in the academic subjects?) and
- Teacher recommendation

In grades K-2, where there are no state standardized tests, the three other factors (equal weight) listed above will be considered when determining a students’ eligibility to participate in Title I programs.
